Opening Comments:

Chairwoman Hutchinson welcomed participants to the meeting. Chairwoman Hutchinson gave a brief overview of the board's tour of Black Hills Energy's Cheyenne Prairie Generating Station. She also talked about the WEA's hosted legislative lunch.

MOTION: Motion made by Mark to approve the agenda, seconded by Wanda. Chairwoman Hutchinson amended the agenda to change *December* minutes to *January* minutes.

Executive Director's Report::

Rob Creager started this update by talking about the legislative budget and how this might impact our EMF funds. The legislature did approve (2) positions for WEA at this time. More updates on energy matching funds will be given to the board when the session is closed. Rob and the board recognized Paul Ulrich for his time serving on the board. Rob gave some time for Lon Whitman to present about CO₂-EOR Essentials. Lon presented a slide presentation and answered questions.

Project Updates:

BWXT as well as Frontier Carbon Solutions both gave project updates. These are both projects that are being partially funded by grants from WEA. BWXT is working in Nuclear Technology for reactors, fuel, mining, and data centers.

Frontier Carbon Solutions are working on carbon storage. Their CarbonSAFE carbon storage is currently targeting a Q3 2024 construction start date.

Both companies took questions from the board directly after their presentations.

WEA Staff Updates:

Jami Blosmo went over the financial reports given to the board and answered questions. Patrick Millin talked about Energy Efficiency Grant as well as the GRID Resilience Program.

Anja Richmond spoke about the Energy Matching Funds. The most recent round had 9 submissions, 3 were asked for RFP's. The EMF review committee met on 2/27/24 and voted to recommend 2 of the projects be funded. Those 2 will now be presented to the Governor for final approval.

Public Comments:

Glenn Murrell spoke on collaboration between WEA and the Idaho National Lab. He also thanked Paul for his service to the board.

Scott Dobson spoke to let everyone know how well Wyoming is leading the way on energy interventions and projects.

Other Board Matters:

Holly Krutka spoke on how decisions made in the legislature session could affect SER projects as well as staffing and urged board members to help in any way possible.

MOTION: Motion made by Mark to move to executive session, Donna seconded. Approved. Board moved to executive session at 4:25. Meeting adjourned at 5:15.
