WYLite Energy Audit

This program offers free energy audits to organizations interested in the K-12 and Local Government grant programs. It is a requirement that interested grantees first complete this program. Once applicants have signed up online for the WYLite Energy Audit, they will be contacted by Wyoming Energy Authority's consultant.

March 1 – May 31, 2024

K-12 Schools Retrofit

The K-12 Schools grants are available to any public school in Wyoming that is looking to complete approved energy efficiency retrofits.

- Maximum grant amount is \$50,000
- No required cash match
- Requires WYLite Energy Audit
- March 1 May 31, 2024

Local Government Retrofit

The Local Government Retrofit grants are available to local governments looking to complete approved energy efficiency retrofits. Examples of local government projects include city halls, fire departments, police departments, town centers, etc.

- Maximum grant amount is \$50,000
- 10% required cash match
- Requires WYLite Energy Audit
- March 1 May 31, 2024
